Through the years, changes were made, veterans from other wars were eventually admitted, and a fight to prevent the home's closure ensued. All were part of the story.

Ms. House, an active member of the Smithville Historical Society, researched the home's history and gathered images, both inside and out, for her program. Her knowledge of the home complements her special interest of documenting and recognizing the lives and service of local veterans.
